Televised Mass receives endowment support

COLUMBUS - The James and Naomi Curtis Memorial Endowment Fund of The Catholic Foundation of the Catholic Diocese of Columbus has distributed \$1,830 to the diocesan Communications Office to support the Diocese of Columbus Televised Mass.

The funds will assist in paying airtime costs for the broadcast of the Mass on four television outlets in the Diocese of Columbus for those who because of illness or other reasons beyond their control are unable to attend Sunday Mass.

The Televised Mass is broadcast on Sundays on WWHO-TV in Columbus at 7:30 a.m.; at 7 a.m. on WHIZ-TV in Zanesville; on Cable Channel 2 in Marion and Tuscarawas counties at 11 a.m., and on Cable Channel 20 of Adelpia Cable in Scioto County at 11 a.m.
