Natural Family Planning Classes Offered in April

Columbus – A five-session series of Natural Family Planning (NFP) classes will begin on Tuesday April 28, from 7-9 p.m. at St. Paul the Apostle Church, 313 North State Street, Westerville, Ohio. These classes are designed to assist couples in achieving or postponing pregnancy while strengthening their marriage relationship.

The workshop, offered through the Catholic Diocese of Columbus Marriage and Family Life Office, will continue on Tuesdays: May 12, 26, June 9, and July 7. The registration fee is \$60 which includes all instructional materials; financial assistance is available.

NFP is taught by couples who are nationally certified by the Diocesan Development Program for NFP of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.
