A series of follow-up presentations, which provide a time and place to work on your relationship, is an important phase of the Retrouvaille healing process. The hurt and pain of falling out of love cannot be healed in a single weekend experience. This phase of the Retrouvaille program offers a more relaxed setting to explore other subjects relating to marriage and love, to renew your commitment and to develop new insights and skills.
